Supporting your Child in Spanish



These are some tips and resources on how to support your child in Spanish. There's always a fun way to learn languages! Try these resources and tips and add any that you think may work for them.

Listening tips

Watch a Youtube video in Spanish and ask your child to write down 5 words that they heard in the video.

Watch 15 mins of a Spanish film and ask your child to summarise what they heard and saw.



Reading tips

Improve your childs vocabulary by encouraging them to use **Quizlet** for 5 minutes every day.

Use **Readlang.com** to introduce your child to Spanish texts, and encourage them to look up any vocabulary they didnô know.

Writing tips

Write 3 sentences a week about the current topic studied in Spanish.

Ask your child to write your shopping list in Spanish!



Speaking tips

Use **Quizlet** to help them listen to how words are pronounced i have a go yourself!

Ask them to read aloud some of the work they have done in class, and to teach you how to read it too!
